JOB SUMMARY: Under the direct supervision of the Superintendent of Public Works and General Services, performs skilled and semi-skilled maintenance work at city facilities and on city equipment. Performs other work to assist in city operations as directed by the superintendent.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS: Performs work in:

- the maintenance of city streets and all public rights-of-way
- the maintenance of municipal buildings, equipment, parks and grounds
- the operation of the city's water distribution system and sewerage collection system

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS and REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, EXPERIENCE & ABILITIES:

Education: Two years of high school

Other Requirements: Valid Michigan Class 0 License

Required Knowledge, Skills/Experience & Abilities: The physical demands described here are representative: reach above and below shoulder level, use hands/arms with repetitive twisting and pressure movements, push and pull objects, climb, stand, walk, lift and carry up to 50 pounds, stoop, bend, lean, turn and twist body; bend, crouch, kneel and squat on repeated basis; perform coordinated movements, distinguish shades and colors, listen for distinctive sounds. Work is performed indoors and outdoors, in all types of weather; activities are performed during day, evening and night hours.
