

**Emergency Financial Manager of the City of Ecorse
(Directive No. 028)**

**ORDER OF THE EMERGENCY FINANCIAL MANAGER OF THE CITY OF ECORSE,
COUNTY OF WAYNE, STATE OF MICHIGAN, APPROVING PAYMENT OF CLAIMS,
MOVING PROPOSED ORDINANCE AMENDMENTS AND ADDITIONS TO FIRST READING
AND THE APPROVAL OF CERTAIN HAWKER/PEDDLER LICENSES.**

WHEREAS, under the Local Government Fiscal Responsibility Act, Act 72, Public Acts of Michigan, 1990, as amended ("Act 72") and a Contract (the "Contract") between the State of Michigan and Joyce A. Parker, dated October 30, 2009, Joyce A. Parker has been appointed as the Emergency Financial Manager (the "EFM") of the City of Ecorse, County of Wayne, Michigan (the "City") and charged with the power to take actions with respect to the City, including the power to exercise the authority and responsibilities of the Mayor, as the Chief Administrative Officer of the City, and of the City Council, as the governing body of the City, concerning the adoption, amendment and enforcement of ordinances or resolutions affecting the financial condition of the City as provided in the Home Rule City Act, Act 279, Public Acts of Michigan, 1909, as amended ("Act 279"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Act 72 and the Contract, the EFM, as the Chief Administrative Officer of the City, is authorized to, among other things, make, approve or disapprove any appropriation, contract, expenditure, or loan for the City, as well as, exercise the authority and responsibilities of the chief administrative officer and governing body concerning the adoption, amendment, and enforcement of ordinances or resolutions affecting the financial condition of the city as she may deem necessary, within her sole discretion, to accomplish the purposes of Act 72; and.

WHEREAS, at the regular meeting of the City Council held on June 15, 2010 at 7:30 o'clock pm, pursuant to Chapter V Section 6 of the Charter of the City of Ecorse, Council member attendance failed to achieve the required quorum and, therefore, there was no transaction of business.

WHEREAS it is in the best interests of the City to pay its vendors, claims and accounts as reviewed and approved by the City's Financial Controller and Emergency Financial Manager so as to limit the City's liability and continue to be in compliance with financial accounting standards and practices. Therefore, the City shall pay the claims and accounts as submitted by the Emergency Financial Manager on June 15, 2010 and that said claims and accounts shall be paid from the proper funds in the total amount of \$38,789.09.

WHEREAS it is in the best interests of the City to amend its ordinances to enact and establish a current fee schedule, specifically amending Chapter 2 Section 2.233 Building Fees, Section 2.234 Electrical Fees, Section 2.235 Plumbing Fees, Section 2.236 Mechanical Fees, in order to increase or change certain fees, and add Section 2.232(a) as a municipal civil infraction enforcement remedy for certain identified violations. In furtherance of the enactment of the afore referenced City Ordinance amendments and additions, pursuant to Chapter IX, Section 1 and all other pertinent provisions of the City of Ecorse Charter the Emergency Financial Manager shall hereby direct all Ordinance amendments and additions to first reading to allow for publication and discussion of same.

WHEREAS it is in the best interests of the City to allow individuals the opportunity to sell goods, wares or merchandise within the City limits to the extent allowed under the Ordinances of the City of Ecorse but only upon the full payment and procurement of the Ordinance required hawker and peddler license and/or business license. Applicants have filed approved applications in accordance with the process set forth in Chapter 19 of the Ordinances of the City of Ecorse. Therefore, the EFM acknowledges the submission by Hala Jihad Baydoun of the required and approved application and renewal for a Hawker/Peddler License from May 1, 2010 to April 30, 2011, together with the required fee paid in full to allow him to sell ice cream and popsicles from his ice cream truck and desires to issue an approved license. Further, the EFM acknowledges the submission by Kenneth Cook, doing business as Skyway Incorporated, of the required and

approved application and renewal for a Hawker/Peddler License from May 1, 2010 to April 30, 2011 which includes proof of financial responsibility through a current insurance policy, listing of the tested fireworks products for sale, a description of his sales set up, and a signed permission document from the retail property owner of the anticipated sales site, together with the required fee paid in full to allow him to sell fireworks as allowed and in compliance with Public Act 328 of 1931 and desires to issue an approved license.


This Directive is necessary in order to carry out the duties and responsibilities required of the Emergency Financial Manager as set forth in Public Act 72, the contract between the Local Emergency Financial Assistance Loan Board and the Emergency Financial Manager and, additionally, is considered necessary to implement the financial plan.

RESOLVED, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE EMERGENCY FINANCIAL MANAGER OF THE CITY OF ECORSE, PURSUANT TO PUBLIC ACT 72 AND THE CONTRACT, THAT:

1. The claims and accounts as submitted by the Emergency Financial Manager on June 15, 2010 be paid from the proper funds in the total amount of \$38,759.09:

General Fund	\$16,754.74
CDGB	\$18,000.00
Water and Sewer	\$ 4,004.35
2. Ordinance provisions amending Chapter 2 Section 2.233 Building Fees, Section 2.234 Electrical Fees, Section 2.235 Plumbing Fees, Section 2.236 Mechanical Fees, in order to increase or change certain fees, and the addition of Section 2.232(a) as a municipal civil infraction enforcement remedy for certain identified violations are hereby moved to the first reading to allow for publication and discussion of same.
3. The following Hawker/Peddler licenses are hereby approved for issuance:
 - A. Hala Jihad Baydoun for a Hawker/Peddler License from May 1, 2010 to April 30, 2011 to allow him to sell ice cream and popsicles from his ice cream truck; and
 - B. Kenneth Cook, doing business as Skyway Incorporated, for a Hawker/Peddler License from May 1, 2010 to April 30, 2011 to allow him to sell fireworks as allowed and in compliance with Public Act 328 of 1931. Said license shall clearly state that Mr Cook must, at all times, be in full compliance with Public Act 328 of 1931, shall be responsible to ensure that fireworks are not activated by anyone, including buyers from and on said sales site.
4. Repeal. All orders of the EFM, resolutions of the City Council of the City and parts of resolutions or orders in conflict with this Order are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
